Exhibits entered must have been completed within two years of the current show.

Entry forms & exhibits (non-perishable & perishable) must be received by Burke Shire Council before the final closing dates & time as stated in the Programme.

NO LATE ENTRIES OR EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER FINAL CLOSING DATE & TIME.

Identification

All names of exhibitors will be absent from judging. Commercial and company labels on exhibits is prohibited.

Each exhibitor will be issued an 'exhibitor number' for judging purposes. This information is confidential & will remain undisclosed until the final results are decided upon.

Judging

Exhibits which do not fit into the criteria as set out in this Programme will not be judged.

Stewards are given the right to reclassify entries where it is deemed appropriate.

All exhibits entered will be judged by the Burke Shire Councils 2011 Arts N Craft Advisory Groups pre-selected panel of judges. Judges with conflicting interests in relation to any entered exhibits will be removed from judging these works.

Judging of exhibits will be unbiased at all times. **THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL.**

Liability & Insurance

All Burke Shire Council 2011 Arts N Craft Show Advisory Group members, judge, steward, officer or volunteer will not be liable in any way for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage to any exhibits.
