The live export debacle highlighted a definite need for restructure and reinvigoration at all levels of industry representation. Even though there is a mood for change it is going to be hard to achieve as the current setup is very undemocratic and no one party wants to assume ownership.

Grassroots level industry participants are far removed from the process and, in many instances, it is only through membership of State based industry organisations such as Agforce, that an individual can hope to gain entry onto committees or indirectly try to make their issues heard. These State industry organisations represent at best 30% of producers, which means that 70% have no voice in our National peak industry bodies.
