Please note the following information concerning the current flooding situation in Burketown.

Flood Level - 6.7 metres at Burketown Airport

## Expected Peak

Peak expected some time in next 24 hours. Flowrate currently slowing down, now approx 50% of flowrate early this morning (Monday)

## How to get Information Updates

Regular information updates will be made available and posted at all usual bulletinboards in town and known email addresses, as well as on the Council's website.

## Water and Sewerage Services

All water and sewerage services are currently operational.

## Relocation/Evacuation

Residents in low-lying areas of town should prepare for possible evacuations in the event of possible services failure of the sewerage systems.

## Boats

Please use boats safely and at low speeds as not to create a nuisance for other residents.

## Aerodrome

Services in and out of the Burketown Aerodrome are currently suspended owing to partial flooding of the runway.

## General Warning

Residents are requested to exercise extreme caution in all activities around the home and in flooded areas. Be aware that emergency and medical evacuation will be difficult while the aerodrome is closed.
