Notes

- (1) In accordance with the descriptions in schedule 5, items 2(a) (iii),(iv) and (vii), the boundary of the Nationally Important Wetland and Fish Habitat Area for land in the Town zone at Burketown and Gregory (as shown on maps ZM2, ZM3 and ZM4) is the boundary of the Albert or Gregory River closest to the Town zone. The boundary of the Albert River is taken to be as shown on ZM3 and ZM4. The overlay provisions of the planning scheme for the Nationally Important Wetlands and Fish Habitat Area apply within those wetlands and also within 100 m of the wetland boundaries (while land within the Town zone is not within the Nationally Important Wetland and Fish Habitat Area, it may be within 100m of the wetland boundaries).
- (2) The DPI Queensland Fisheries Service is undergoing a programme of updating the Fish Habitat Areas (FHA) mapping to register accurately to the DCDB. The Eight Mile Creek FHA has not been updated through this process yet and is instead registered to Topographic features from official A4 plans, which do not necessarily align with cadastral boundaries. In accordance with the definition in schedule 6 of the planning scheme, for land included in the Town zone at Burketown (as shown on maps ZM2 and ZM3), the boundary of the erosion prone area is the boundary of the Albert River closest to the Town zone, as shown on ZM2 and ZM3. The overlay provisions of the planning scheme for the erosion prone area overlay apply within the erosion prone area and also within 100 m of the boundary of the area.
- (3) The overlay provisions of the planning scheme for the cultural heritage features identified on this map apply if the site area incorporates the feature and also if the site area is within 40 m of the feature.
